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1 Introduction

The Last Mile Supply Monitoring (LMSM) Analytics is designed to analyze and visualize LMSM data, enabling efficient monitoring and informed decision-making. It provides a comprehensive overview of supplies across all stages of the LMSM process, while also allowing users to explore detailed information at each stage.

The LMSM Global Team is committed to the continuous improvement of analytics by incorporating user feedback and enhancing the application. This document outlines the updates made to the analytics, with the aim of guiding users through these changes and serving as a reference for the dashboard's components and features, as described in the sections below.

2 Unit of Measurement (UOM) selection buttons

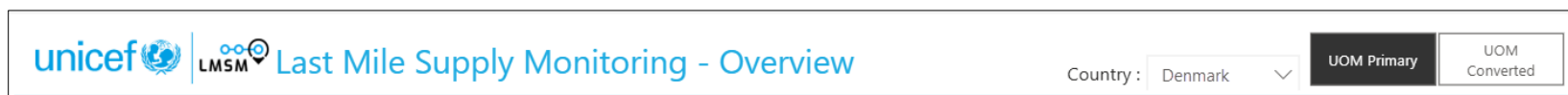


Fig 1: UOM selection button – Before

2.1 Previously, the UOM selection buttons were labelled "**UOM Primary**" and "**UOM Converted**". For RUTF, upon selecting UOM Primary, the units would switch to Cartons; upon selecting UOM Converted, the units would switch to Sachets. (Fig 1)

2.2 The Unit of Measure (UOM) selection buttons are now labelled "**Primary Unit**" and "**Secondary Unit**". Depending on the product selected and the unit being chosen, the "**Selected Unit**" field will display the corresponding unit name for that product.

- The Primary Unit is indicated by a blue background.
- The Secondary Unit is indicated by a green background.

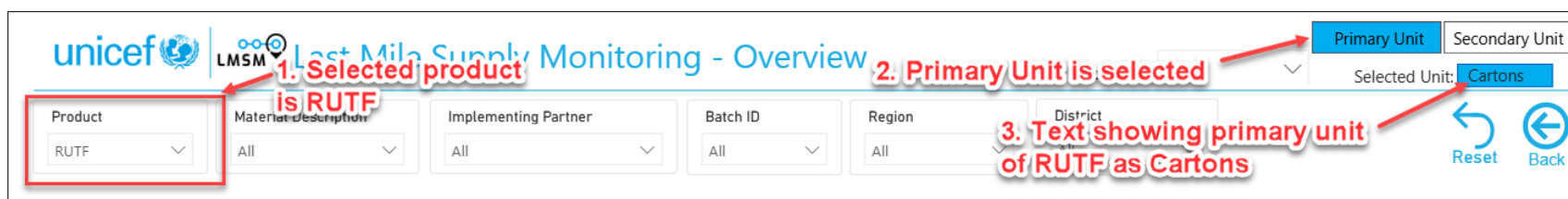


Fig 2: Product RUTF, primary unit

If both the primary and secondary units of a product are identical, the "Selected Unit" field will reflect the same unit for both selections. (Fig 2, Fig 3, Fig 4, Fig 5)

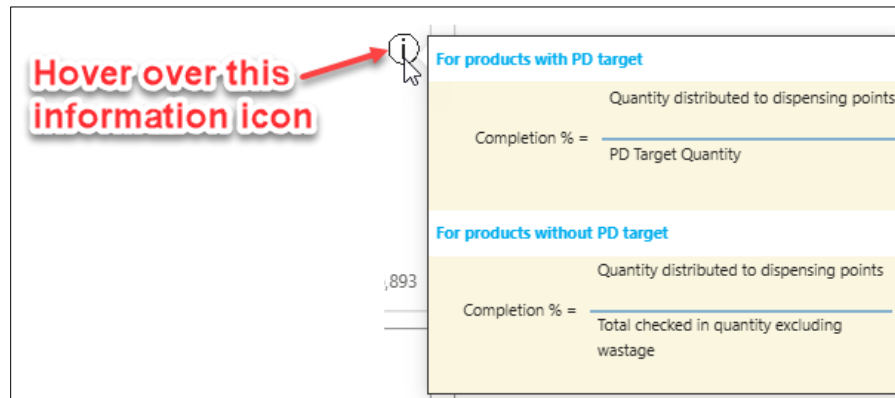


Fig 7: Progress percentage calculation

4 Pages consolidation and renaming (June 2026)

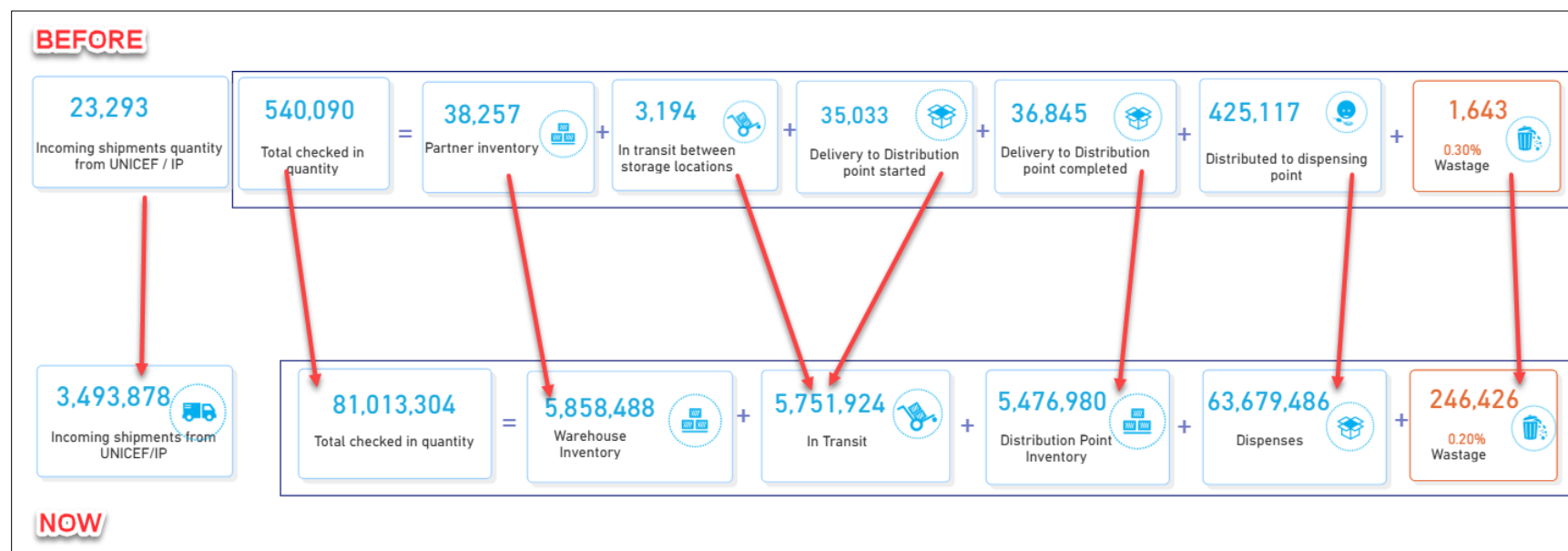


Fig 8: Before-After, pages consolidation and renaming

- 4.1 **Incoming shipments from UNICEF/IP**, **Total checked in quantity**, and **Wastage** pages remain the same. (Fig 8)
- 4.2 **Partner Inventory** is renamed to **Warehouse Inventory**. (Fig 8)
- 4.3 **In transit between storage locations** and **Delivery to Distribution point started** are consolidated to form a single “**In Transit**” card. Both of these show supplies moving from one storage location to another storage location or distribution point. (Fig 8)
- 4.4 **Delivery to distribution point completed** is renamed to **Distribution Point Inventory**. This card shows supplies available in distribution point storage locations. (Fig 8)
- 4.5 **Distribution to dispensing point** is renamed as **Dispenses**. (Fig 8)

5 In transit page changes (June 2026)

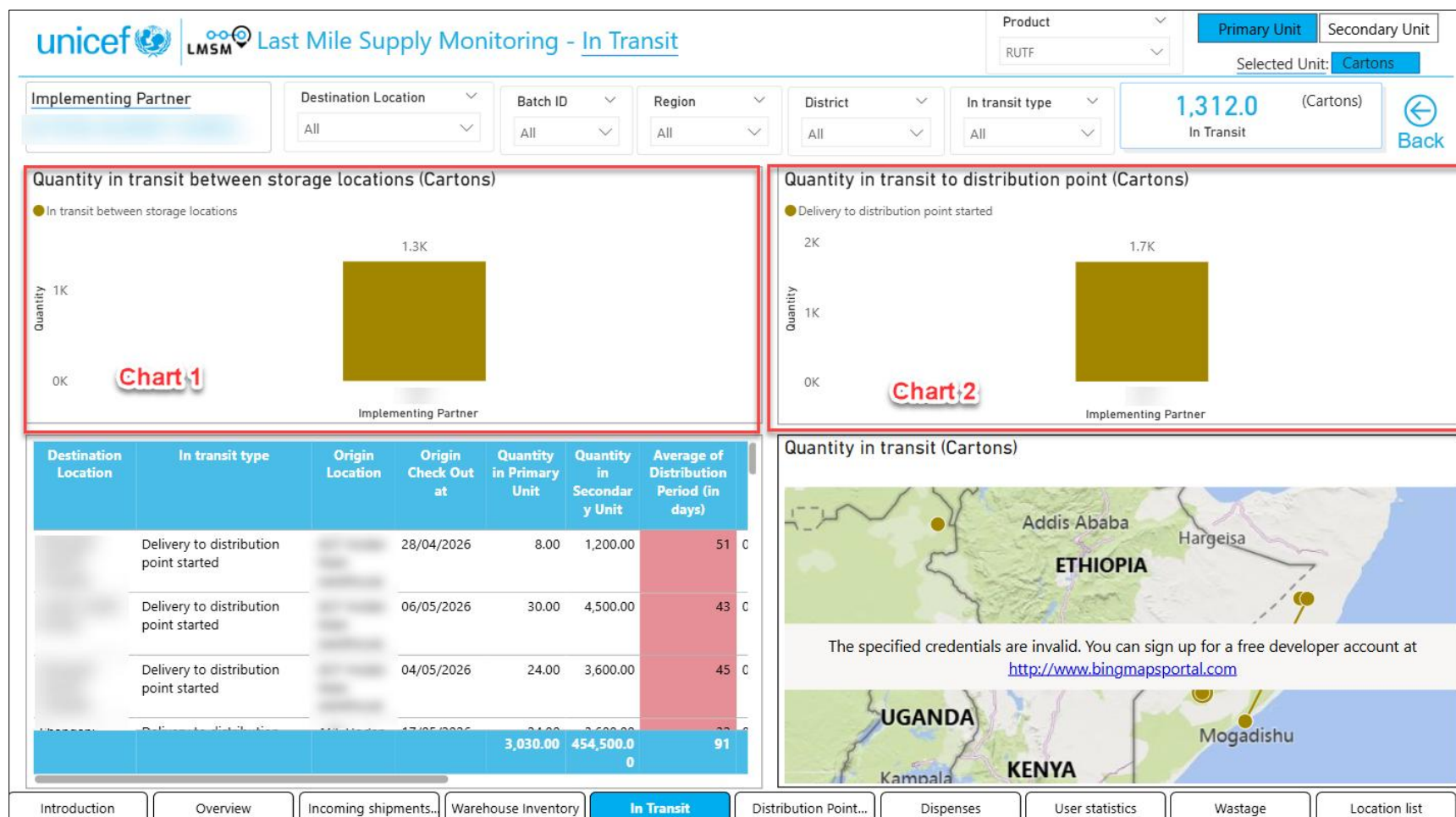


Fig 9: In transit page charts
